

APPLICATION PROCEDURE FOR THE 11th ROBERTO

VILLAGRAZ SCHOLARSHIP

EFTI School of Photography and Image Centre announces its 11th Roberto Villagraz scholarship of Photography, aiming to award three photographers with a scholarship that will enable them to develop their professional career through the study of EFTI International Master of Photography ((Máster de Concepto y Creación ó Máster de Documentalismo y Narración), at the school free of charge.

The cost of the course for this edition [2013-14] is 8.690 €

Each of the awarded students will receive a monetary prize of 1,200€ as well.

Under no circumstances will the prize be changed for cash.

There is no application fee.

No prize will remain unawarded.

APPLICANTS

Participation is open to anybody between 18 and 39 years of age (on the final submittal date), regardless of their nationality and academic history.

Winners must attend the course in any of its two next editions, starting in September 2013 or January 2014. The duration of the course is one year.

REQUIREMENTS TO DELIVER THE PROJECTS

Each applicant must present one single series of photographs consisting of 6 to 12 photos that must have a common theme, along with a text that summarizes the project. The photographic technique and the theme are open.

All photographs must be labelled with the name of the applicant and numbered according to their position in the series. E.g: Paul Smith 001

Applications will be sent trough our web site: <http://www.efti.es>, completing the registration form along with the following documentation:

- Photocopy of Identity Card or Passport in jpg format.
- Brief description of the project.
- 6 up to 12 images in jpg format. These must have a maximum of 1.000 pixels on their largest side and 72ppp. Each image can't be bigger than 250 Kb.

DEADLINE FOR SUBMISSIONS

Applications may be sent from **28th of January 2013** until **25th of March 2013 by 10 pm (Spanish time)**. This will not be extended under any circumstances.

SELECTION COMMITTEE

The jury will be made up of prestigious photographers and an EFTI representative.

The jury's decision will be announced on the **16th of April 2013**.

This jury's decision is final. The winners will be notified personally and it will be announced on EFTI's web site (www.efti.es).

The winning photographs may be used by EFTI for broadcasting and in order to promote these grants in this or future editions.

APPENDIX

The winners of the Scholarships will sign an agreement with EFTI, committing themselves to completion of the entire Masters course (one academic year).

Participation involves full acceptance of the above conditions. The committee reserves their right to make decisions on any unforeseen circumstances not covered by the conditions outlined above.

Failure to comply with the above rules, or lack of required documentation will result in the applicant's exclusion from the contest.
