EFTI's (International Centre of Photography and Cinema) announces its **VI Call for Digital Cinematography Scholarship**, which will be prized with the **International Masters in Digital Cinematography** in any of its two branches: Film Direction and Digital Cinematography

### **APPLICANTS**

The applicant must be over 18 years of age and can be of any nationality. The number of videos presented is only ONE.

### **THEME**

#### **Free Theme**

The jury will value, in particular, the artistic and visual quality and the overall of the work submitted.

### **REQUIRED APPLICATION DOCUMENTS**

The videos must not be more than 10 minutes long including the credits. They must be sent in HD quality with opening credits, ending credits and soundtrack with royalty-free content.

Vimeo.com is the chosen presentation platform for the applicants' projects.

The applicants must upload their videos on the platform in PRIVATE option with a password EFTI and permission to be downloaded.

They will also have to maintain the videos private until the names of the finalists and the winner are announced.

Applicants will receive a confirmation email once their video has been approved for the scholarship competition.

The organization reserves the right to not admit videos that according to their criteria do not answer to the theme, technique and/or legal issues required.

### **IDEAL VIDEO FORMAT**

#### IMAGE

- Resolution: 1080p o 720p
- Frame rate: 24, 25 o 30 FPS constant.
- Format: MP4 / Codec H264 de Multistep / Bit rate until 20.000 kbits/s

#### SOUND

- Codec: AAC-LC
- Data rate: 320 kbits/s
- Sample rate: 48 kHz

## **APPLICATION PERIOD**

Applicants can send their video/s from **00:01h of March 21th 2019** to **23:59h of April 28th 2019**.

## **JURY AND RESULTS**

The jury will be composed of various professionals of the field. The **results will be made public at the beginning May 2019**. The jury's decision is irrevocable. The winners of the **VI Call for the Digital Cinematography Scholarship** will be notified personally and their names will be published on [www.efti.es](http://www.efti.es)

## **PRIZE**

The winner of the scholarship will be awarded for the amount of tuition to attend the **International Masters in Cinematography**, in one of its two branches: Film Direction and Digital Cinematography, for the duration of two years valued at €20,910 and €27,475 respectively, which must take at EFTI for the call held in September 2019.

## **ANNEXES**

The author of the prized video will transfer the rights of reproduction, public communication and distribution of their video to EFTI, free of charge as to allow the circulation of the video through any means of communication and any format necessary, including EFTI's web pages, social webs and audio-visual platforms.

The use of these rights will be exclusively for promotional and publicity reasons regarding the scholarship and the course.

## Learn how to tell your story: learn how to film by filming

The International Master in Digital Cinema is a framework where students can develop their creativity and technical skills through an extensive program where they learn to shoot on film with professional digital cinema material.

Growing through the experience of working with international directors and cinematographers. Knowing the laboral future with professionals from the film, advertising and content industry. Thinking from practical contents of analysis and comparative visual culture. Create through an individualized program of project creation tutoring and personal language search. We provide the student with technical excellence, analytical skills, visual culture and creativity that the current market demands.

The Master in Digital Cinema has two specializations: **Direction of Photography** and **Direction and Realization in Digital Cinema**.

During two years, the students participate in the supervised shooting of at least 20 audiovisual pieces; short films, video clips, documentaries and advertising pieces. Pieces of previous promotions have been selected at national festivals such as the Malaga Festival, awarded at international festivals and have received awards such as the prestigious Vimeo Staff Pick. The program concludes with the shooting of two short films of one week.

This program is an ecosystem for the creation of professional networks through workshops with directors, directors of photography, agents, representatives, film and advertising producers, industry commissioners musical, distributors, digital platforms, advertising agencies and technical centers.

Teachers are active professionals, awarded in the most prestigious international festivals, many of them nominated and winners of awards such as OSCARS, BAFTA, CANNES and of course, the GOYA. With them and with the practice teachers our students participate in filming during more than 2,000 hours of workshops and filming in the specialty of Direction and Realization and 1,700 hours of workshops and shootings in Direction of Photography. This supposes an ideal frame to learn to film filming of the hand of great artists and professionals.

The International Master in Digital Cinema is a unique program that answers to the lack of a sound international program focused on the practice of digital cinema that's sensitive to the technological and social changes in our contemporary culture, where students meet and work alongside creators at the vanguard of the industry.
